**2003** On **may 28, 2003** Eric R. Olivieri Beauchamp, former Johnson & Johnson Pharmaceutical Sourcing Administration Group Director for Puerto Rico & Latin America and Osvaldo Carlo Linares, former Chief Civil Division, US Attorney's Office District of Puerto Rico, incorporate Regulatory Compliance Services, Corp. (ReComS Corp.) for the purpose of providing regulator services.

**2004** By **December 2004** ReComS, Corp. had grown from 2 Consultants to 115 Consultant and was conducting a major Third Party Certification for the Food & Drug Administration in a medical device operation.

**2005** On **March 29, 2005** Eric R. Olivieri and Osvaldo Carlo acquire 100 percent of the stock of Accupharma Research & Consulting, Inc. in Humacao, Puerto Rico. Following a major investment in facilities and modern equipment, Accupharma becomes ReComS Laboratories, Inc. a laboratory providing analytical, microbiological testing and consulting as well as method development for the pharmaceutical, medical device, food and cosmetic industry. Number of employees grew from 12 to 45.



On **September 1, 2005** ALTYMA Pharma Services is incorporated in Panama City, Panama, for the purpose of supporting activities in Central and South America.

**2006** On **February 16, 2006** Microbiological Media manufacturing Company, Inc. is incorporated for the purpose of manufacturing culture media and the production of reagent grade water for HPLC used by the FDA regulated industry. A major investment is made in media manufacturing equipment and in one of the most sophisticated water purification systems available in Puerto Rico



On **July 11, 2006** Calibration, Validation, Validation & Research, Inc. (CVR) is incorporated for the purpose of providing calibration and validation services to the manufacturing industry in Puerto Rico. Mr. Ricardo Fonseca, one of only a few certified metrologists in Puerto Rico and a member of the Board of Metrologists for the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico is appointed Director of CVR. Construction of a temperature and humidity; pressure and gas flow; force and dimension; electrical; analytical and colorimetry laboratories are initiated.

On **July 19, 2006**, ALTYMA Pharma Services, Costa Rica, S.A. is registered in the Republic of Costa Rica. ALTYMA Pharma Services will be providing microbiological, calibration, validation and training to the food, drug and cosmetic industry in central and South America. ALTYMA Pharma services will operate from a facility in the Metro Free Zone in San Jose, Costa Rica.

On **July 25, 2006** ReComS is awarded the Johnson & Johnson 2006 Supplier Diversity performance award for exceptional performance by a small supplier. This is an award directed at suppliers that supported the worldwide operations of Johnson & Johnson.



**2007** On January 19, 2007 the Puerto Rico Industrial Development Company (PRIDCO) informs the newsmedia that Calibration, Validation and Research, Inc. is the company with the largest investment among those renting government facilities in Puerto Rico.



May 4, 2007, Calibration, Validation and Research, Inc. (CVR) is scheduled to inaugurate its new facilities, in Humacao Puerto Rico in an activity that includes as guests several government officials, including the Governor of Puerto Rico, the Honorable Anibal Acevedo Vilá. CVR emerges as the prime calibration and validation in Puerto Rico and the Caribbean. With the support of a modern laboratory, CVR will be providing services for calibration in diverse areas such as temperature, pressure, electronics, mass dimension and thermometry.
